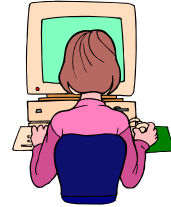


INTERNET ACCEPTABLE USE

Keeping SMART online!

Remember these 5 SMART safety tips when you are using the Internet to communicate to people you don't know. For further explanation on why these tips are important see www.kidsmart.org.uk/smart

S SAFE – staying safe involves being careful and not giving out your name, address, mobile phone number, school name or password to people.

M MEETING – someone you may have contacted in cyberspace can be dangerous. Only do so with your parent's permission and then when they can be present.

A ACCEPTING – emails or opening files from people you don't know or trust can make problems – they may contain viruses or nasty messages.

R REMEMBER – someone online may be lying and not be who they say they are. If you feel uncomfortable, tell an adult and end the conversation.

T TELL – your parent or teacher if someone or something makes you feel uncomfortable or worried.
